Parissa juggles her teaching and choirs with travelling the world performing with The Hottentots, with whom she has recorded 6 award winning albums. Her debut solo CD won Dolphin Music Awards for Song of the Year, Best Jazz, and Best World Music 2012 & 2013.

When not touring, Parissa runs the 'Lighthouse Voices' community choir in Byron Bay, performance master classes for HSC students and maintains a busy private voice studio.
